1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution

This session has been a very significant one for a number of reasons. To begin with the U.G.C. review committee visited the college recently and extended its autonomy upto 2013, which has consolidated the position of the college as an autonomous college in the central university structure.

As a college with Potential for Excellence the college has laid the foundation to convert itself into one e-learning hub for which an e-library has been commissioned which was inaugurated by Prof. Pushp Bhargava, former Deputy Chairman, Knowledge Commission, Government of India. The e-library which comprises of two halls with 132 computers in all has been very well received by the part-III students who were seen making full use of this facility offered by the college.

Another notable development is the establishment of a Human Resource Development Centre for imparting training to the staff members in the modern methods of teaching. This too has been greatly appreciated by the teachers, juniors and seniors alike who are flocking to the centre to equip themselves with the knowledge of computers and its applications so that they keep abreast 'with

the best that is known and thought throughout out the world' and transmit the same to the students through improved teaching methodology.

Today with the world turning into a Global Market and the entry of multinationals into the field, there is an unending horizon of opportunities for young men and women with talents in specialized areas who are being offered lucrative jobs if they can ably fill up the required slot. Hence there is a clear shift of preference from traditional courses to professional courses. The college cannot afford to lag behind and is bracing itself up to face the challenges in the days to come.
