IMPORATANT NOTICE FOR STUDENTS OF B.A./B. Sc./B. Com./BCA/B. Voc. SEM-2, 4 AND M.A./M.Sc. SEM-2

The above students may kindly note the following.

1. As per our previous notice and judgement of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, a written examination will be conducted for all students of B.A. / B. Sc. / B. Com. / BCA / B. Voc. Semester VI and M.A. / M. Sc. Semester IV. The examination will begin on **September 14, 2020** and complete time-table will be soon uploaded on the College Website.
2. The format of question paper for all UG courses is as follows:
 - a. Only four questions have to be attempted and duration of examination is two hours.
 - b. There will be two sections only i.e. Section - A & Section - B
 - c. Section - A will have three short answers questions with internal choice out of which only two have to be attempted.
 - d. Section - B will have three long answers questions with internal choice out of which only two have to be attempted.
3. The format of question paper for all M.A./M. Sc. Course is as follows:
 - a. Duration of examination is two hours.
 - b. There will be five questions with internal choices out of which only four questions have to be attempted.
4. Those students of UG Semester VI who could not submit their Assignments/Tutorials before lockdown have to submit it before the beginning of the End Semester examination schedule from **14th September 2020**.
5. Those departments of Art's faculty which conduct written exams in place of Assignments/Tutorials will do so after giving proper information to the concerned students.
6. As already informed, all students of B.A./B. Sc./B. Com./BCA/B. Voc. SEM-2 and 4 or M.A./M. Sc. SEM-2 will be promoted to the ensuing Odd Semester as per UGC directives. After declaration of result all such students who are not satisfied with their marks will be given another opportunity to appear in examination in one or more subjects. *This provision is applicable only for the session 2019-2020 in view of Corona pandemic and shall not be treated as precedence.*
7. As already informed, all students of B.A./B. Sc./B. Com./BCA/B. Voc. SEM-2 and 4 or M.A./M. Sc. SEM-2 who are unable to pass will be **provisionally promoted** to the ensuing Odd Semester as per UGC directives. After declaration of result all such students will also be given another opportunity to appear in examination in one or more subjects. *This provision is applicable only for the session 2019-2020 in view of Corona pandemic and shall not be treated as precedence.*
8. Since all students are being promoted to the ensuing odd semester, they are required to submit their fee in online mode through College website starting from 03rd September, 2020 to 10th September, 2020 and thereafter they will be able to avail the benefits of online classes. The time table of Online classes will soon be uploaded on the College website.
9. All students promoted to UG Semester V are required to fill their subject combination form while depositing their fees online.
10. **The students are required to give their E-Mail address while depositing their fees which will be used to send all information regarding online classes.**
