

10. ELIGIBILITY RULES FOR ADMISSION IN UG AND PG PROGRAMS

10.1 Admission in UG Program

A student who has passed Intermediate Examinations of the Board of High School and Intermediate Education, Uttar Pradesh, or any equivalent examination of any other Board or University in India, incorporated by any law for the time being in force, or any examinations recognized by the University of Allahabad as equivalent thereof and has secured regular admission in the College, in UG Course Sem. I, may be admitted to the UG Course semester I examinations of the college, as per rules. **The maximum time span allowed to pass UG course shall be for a period of six years from the time of his/her admission.**

10.2 Admission in PG Program

10.2.1 No student shall be eligible for admission to a Master's degree programme in any of the faculties unless he/she has successfully completed three years of an undergraduate degree / Honors programmes for an undergraduate degree, through the examinations conducted by a university/autonomous institution or possesses such qualifications as recognized by the concerned university as equivalent to an undergraduate degree.

10.2.2 The admission shall be strictly on the basis of merit which has been formed after the Post Graduate Admission Test conducted by the college which has taken note of all the reservation policies of the Government of India prevalent at that time.

10.2.3 Student Enrollment:-

The college will admit students as per the following criteria.

1. In Subjects without practicals the total intake will be 50 students per subjects
2. In subjects with practicals the total intake will be 30 students per subject.

Note:

1. In subjects without practicals the minimum quota of 15 students will be mandatory for the running of the course.
2. In subjects with practicals the minimum quota of 10 students will be mandatory for the running of the course.

10.2.4 The department running the post graduate programme will ensure all the Academic and Physical facilities including Library and Laboratory facilities are up to date for the smooth running of the programme

10.3 ELIGIBILITY RULES FOR EVALUATION, PASSING, PROMOTION AND AWARD OF DEGREE IN THE THREE YEAR UG PROGRAM

10.3.1 Minimum Passing Percentage: The student must obtain at least 33% separately in Theory and Practical of each subject including the marks of internal assessment and tutorial assignment as well as 33% in the AECC/SEC. Note that the marks obtained in internal assessment and tutorial assignment will be incorporated in the total of theory marks.

10.3.2. Students who have either passed or been promoted in the third semester and fourth semester but have yet to clear the carry over papers of first and second semester will be provisionally allowed to take admission in the fifth semester. However they will have to clear the carry over papers of previous semesters for the award of degree failing which they will have to appear in these carry over papers as Ex- Students as and when these papers are conducted in the appropriate semester.

10.3.3. Students who have yet to clear or pass the AECC/SEC examination are also allowed to take provisional admission in the next semester with a clear understanding that no degree will be awarded to them unless they clear these papers in any of the subsequent semesters in which they are conducted.

10.3.4. When a student registers to appear in the carry over papers he / she will be allowed to appear in the Internal Assessment test as well as Tutorial/ Assignment / Project. In case the student does not appear in these examinations, the previous marks he / she obtained will be carried forward. In the case he / she appears in these examinations then the better of the two marks will be awarded.

10.3.5. Debarment from appearing in semester end examination: Any student may be debarred from appearing in any semester end examination in case of the following

(i) If he/she has been debarred or rusticated from the College by the Proctorial board on grounds of indiscipline/misbehavior.

(ii) If he/she has failed to pay fee dues or library dues.

10.3.6 There is no provision for back / second / improvement examination w.e.f. the academic session 2016 – 17.

10.4 Passing/Promotion criteria during semesters:

10.4.1 FIRST SEMESTER COURSE

After the declaration of results of the First Semester Examination, students will be placed in one of the following two categories:

- a. **Passed:** Students who have passed as per Section 10.3.1 separately in theory and practical in each of the subjects and also in the AECC papers opted by him/her, will be admitted to the 2nd semester.
- b. **Promoted:** Those students who do not fulfill the above criteria of Passed will be *promoted* provisionally to the 2nd semester. He/she will have to pass the carry over paper compulsorily in the appropriate subsequent semester examination as and when it is conducted.

10.4.2 SECOND SEMESTER COURSE

After the declaration of results of the Second Semester Examination, students will be placed in one of the following categories:

- a. **Passed:** Students who have clearly passed second semester as per Section 10.3.1 separately in theory and practical in each of the subjects and also in the AECC papers opted by him/her, will be admitted to the 3rd semester.
- b. **Promoted:** Students who have failed in one subject and have obtained minimum 27% aggregate marks of the 1st and 2nd semester in that subject or have failed / failed to appear in the AECC examination will be provisionally promoted to the 3rd semester but will have to clearly pass the carry over papers / AECC Examinations in the next appropriate subsequent semester as and when the next semester examination is conducted.
- c. **Failed:** Students who have failed in more than one subject or have obtained less than 27% marks in one subject of the stream thereby not satisfying the criteria of *Passed* will be declared failed.

Note: Such students will have the choice to appear in either those subjects (Theory and Practical both) in which he / she has failed or may appear in all the subjects as an Ex – Student in the subsequent semesters of the next academic session.

10.4.3 THIRD SEMESTER COURSE

After the declaration of results of the Third Semester Examination, the students will be placed under following two categories:

- a. **Passed:** Students who have passed as per Section 10.3.1 separately in theory and practical in each of the subjects and also in the SEC papers opted by him/her, will be admitted to the 4th semester.
- b. **Promoted:** Those students who do not fulfill the above criteria of Passed will be *promoted* provisionally to the 4th semester. He/she will have to pass the carry over paper compulsorily in the appropriate subsequent semester examination as and when it is conducted.

10.4.4 FOURTH SEMESTER COURSE

After the declaration of results of the Fourth Semester Examination, the students will be placed under any of the following two categories:

- a. Passed:** Students who have clearly passed second semester as per Section 10.3.1 separately in theory and practical in each of the subjects and also in the SEC papers opted by him/her, will be admitted to the 5th semester.
- b. Promoted: there will be the following two categories:**
1. Students who have failed in one subject and have obtained minimum 27% aggregate marks of the 3rd and 4th semester in that subject or have failed / failed to appear in the SEC examination will be provisionally promoted to the 3rd semester but will have to clearly pass the carry over papers / SEC Examinations in the next appropriate subsequent semester as and when the next semester examination is conducted.
 2. Students who have either passed or been promoted in the third semester and fourth semester but have yet to clear the carry over papers of first and second semester will be provisionally allowed to take admission in the fifth semester as per section 10.3.2.
- d. Failed:** Students who have failed in more than one subject or have obtained less than 27% marks in one subject of the stream thereby not satisfying the criteria of *Passed* will be declared failed.
- Note:** Such students will have the choice to appear in either those subjects (Theory and Practical both) in which he / she has failed or may appear in all the subjects as an Ex – Student in the subsequent semesters of the next academic session.

10.4.5 FIFTH SEMESTER COURSE

Eligibility:

- a. Students who have passed all the subjects of all the previous semesters (1st to 4th) as per section 10.3.1 will be allowed to take admission in the fifth semester.
- b. Students who have been promoted to the 5th semester after the declaration of the result of the 4th semester examination will be allowed to take provisional admission in the fifth semester.
- c. Students who have been provisionally promoted as per section 10.3.2 will be allowed to take admission provisionally in the 5th semester.

Option for selection of subjects: Students seeking admission in 5th semester will have to leave one of the three subjects.

After the declaration of results of the Fifth Semester Examination, the students will be placed under any of the following two categories:

- a. Passed:** Students who have passed as per Section 10.3.1 separately in theory and practical in each of the subjects and also in the SEC papers opted by him/her, will be admitted to the 6TH semester.

- b. Promoted:** Those students who do not fulfill the above criteria of Passed will be *promoted* provisionally to the 6th semester. He/she will have to pass the carry over paper compulsorily in the appropriate subsequent semester examination as and when it is conducted.

10.4.6 SIXTH SEMESTER COURSE

After the declaration of results of the Sixth Semester Examination, the students will be placed under any of the following two categories:

- a. Passed:** Students who have clearly passed second semester as per Section 10.3.2 separately in theory and practical in each of the subjects and also in the SEC papers opted by him/her, will be qualified graduates of the college.
- b. Failed:** Students who have failed in more than one subject or have obtained less than 27% marks in one subject of the stream thereby not satisfying the criteria of *Passed* will be declared failed.

Note:Such students will have the choice to appear in either those subjects (Theory and Practical both) in which he / she has failed or may appear in all the subjects as an Ex – Student in the subsequent semesters of the next academic session.

10.5 ELIGIBILITY FOR AWARD OF DEGREE FOR UNDERGRADUATE COURSES:

10.5.1. A student will be admitted for the award of Bachelors Degree in any of the UG courses if at the end of the 6th semester he / she has clearly passed all the subjects of his choice as well as the AECC and SEC examinations of all the six semesters as given in section 10.3.1.

Note: Students will not be awarded the degree if he / she fails to fulfill the eligibility criteria for award of degree as given in section 10.5.1. and will have to pass the carry over papers as well as the AECC and SEC papers of all of the previous semesters as an Ex – Students.

11 ELIGIBILITY RULES FOR THE EVALUATION, PASSING, PROMOTION AND AWARD OF DEGREE FOR THE TWO YEAR PG PROGRAM

11.1 The examination shall be end at the end of each semester and results announced thereafter.

11.2. Each paper shall carry 100 marks out of which the written papers shall be of 60 marks and internal assessment of 40 marks.

11.3. Format of Question papers for end semester examination of subjects with

Practical/Tutorials:-

Each theory papers will be of 60 marks and the question pattern for the examination will be decided by the respective departments in compliance with the norms of the University of Allahabad as recommended by the respective Board of Studies and duly approved by the Academic Council of the college.

Format of Question papers for internal assessment test of subjects with

=Practical / Tutorial

There will be three internal assessment tests of 20 marks each to be conducted as a Written Test/ Project / Assignment. The final marks obtained by the student will be the total of the best of two tests results.

11.4. Minimum Passing Percentage: For passing a semester examination and for promotion to the next semester (from 1st to 2nd, from 2nd to 3rd and from 3rd to 4th) a student shall have to obtain a minimum of 36% marks in each paper separately of Theory and Practical Examinations including dissertation / thesis / project work (wherever applicable) and a minimum of 48% marks in aggregate. Provided that in respect of the student who have completed to pass of all the four semester of MA / M.Sc. programme in the aforesaid manner, subject to compliance with the clause 11.10.

The division shall be declared on the basis of total marks scored in all the four semester as follows.

- i. first division with honour, where student score 75 % or more marks**
- ii. first division, where student score 60% or more marks**
- iii. second division, where student score 48% above but less than 60 % marks**

11.5. in case, a student fails to score 36% marks in not more than two papers in semesters and in not more than four papers at a time but scores average of 48% marks or more than in remaining papers of the semester concerned he / she shall be promoted to the next semester (from 1st to 2nd, from 2nd to 3rd and from 3rd to 4th) subject to the condition that he / she shall re appear in such paper (s) at the respective semester examination of the ensuing academic session and secure such marks so as to comply with the provision of clause 11.4 subject to the compliance with the provision of clause 11.10.

Provided that incase a student who has reappeared in the aforesaid manner fails to comply with the provision of clause 11.4, he / she shall be promoted to the next semester and allowed to reappear in such paper (s) at respective semester examinations of ensuing academic session, to fulfill the condition clause 11.5, subject to the compliance with the provision of clause 11.10.

11.6. In case a student has scored 36% marks or more marks in all the papers in a semester but fails to score 48% in aggregate he / she shall be promoted to the next semester (from 1st to 2nd,

from 2nd to 3rd and from 3rd to 4th) subject to the condition he / she will re appear in not more than two papers of the semester of ensuing academic session, so as to comply with the provision of clause 11.4 subject to the compliance with the provision of clause 11.10.

Provided that incase a student who has reappeared in the aforesaid manner fails to comply with the provision of clause 11.4, he / she shall be promoted to the next semester and allowed to reappear in such paper (s) at respective semester examinations of ensuing academic session, to fulfill the condition clause 11.6, subject to the compliance with the provision of clause **11.10**

11.7.in case, a student fails to score 36% marks in more than two papers in a semesters and 48% marks in the aggregate in a semester, he / she shall be declared failed in the semester concerned and shall have to appear as an ex – student in all the papers of the respective semester examination of the immediately ensuing academic session as secure such marks so as to comply with the provision of clause 11.4 , 11.5 or 11.6 to get promoted as regular student to the next and subsequent semester subject to the compliance with the provision of clause 11.10.

11.8. in case of student reappearing in the examination as per provision of clause 11.5 and 11.6 or appearing as an ex student as per provision of clause 11.7, his / her internal assessment shall be carry forward in the next examination.

11.9. the final result (Pass / Failed and the division obtained), shall be determined at the end of successful clearance of all the four semesters.

11.10. A STUDENT SHALL BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE AWARD OF M.A. / M.Sc. DEGREE ON HIS / HER CLEARING ALL THE FOUR SEMESTERS WITHIN FOUR ACADEMIC SESSION FROM THE SESSION OF HIS / HER INITIAL ENROLLMENT IN THE PROGRAMME
